

Vuntut Gwitchin Government Media Applications Procedure

The Vuntut Gwitchin Government Heritage Branch is responsible for processing media and research applications for the VGG Traditional Territory. Filmmakers, media, photographers, authors and researchers who are producing film documentaries, writing magazine articles, writing books, researching and photographing for commercial use require an application. These forms are available on our website ([click here](#)). The applications need to be received by the VGG Heritage Branch 30 days prior to the activity. Approved applicants will then sign an agreement with the Vuntut Gwitchin Government outlining any restrictions relating to the activity/project.

Consent

Consent forms are required for photographs, film, and interviews. Draft consent forms should be submitted with the media or research application. Changes may need to be made to the consent forms.

Access to the Vuntut Gwitchin Government Oral History Collection

If you want to access information and photos from our Heritage collections submit the application called “Access to oral history materials.” This application must be filled out by everyone who wants to access and use the information in our collections.
